





.PΦ is one of the largest IDN-domains in the world:

813 400 domain names (for September 1, 2013)



The main problem

Lack of support of cyrillic domains by the largest main services: it's impossible to send a letter for an email address such as following имя@домен.рф

Universal IDN acceptance



AGAINST:

• E-mail functions of the IDN-domains are not in demand so it's too early to speak about cyrillic email support

FOR:

- .PΦ Domain exists for more than 3 years and it's compatible with existing ccTLD on growth speed
- Russian is the second popular language in the world
- In the nearest future the following top level domains will appear: .РУС, .МОСКВА ("Moscow"), .ДЕТИ ("children"), .ОНЛАЙН ("online"), .САЙТ ("site") etc.

Universal IDN acceptance



Coordination Center addressed <u>Microsoft</u> and <u>Facebook</u> asking for a favor to provide email addresses in .PΦ zone and other non-latin domain support

There are active negotiations on starting work on a new protocol launch which will allow to send and receive letters from cyrillic addresses!


Universal IDN acceptance



Apple added new domain zones including .RU and .PФ on standard iPhone keyboard








Anti-phishing and malware research initiative



Cooperation with organizations competent in violation definition in Internet continues



- A specialized platform is being executed for collecting and analysing data on domain names in .RU and .PΦ domains which are used for placing "malefactors" in Internet resources
- Web-site for informational, inquiry and analytical materials on "malefactors" distribution issue publication development has started. Online service on domain name check for using "malefic" activity will be organized as well
