

Distinction. Discoverability. Resource facilitation. A voice.

Addressing the NGO community's needs

Distinction. A trusted environment

Discoverability.

A specific web address and the ability to be searched with relevant criteria and be easily found.

Resource facilitation.

Mechanisms to increase efficiency in areas such as driving donations via information and donor tools

A voice.

Have an on-going dialogue with the community.

- PIR requires validation of NGO status to obtain a domain.
- PIR is launching a searchable directory and supporting profiles that will contain NGO-specific information.
- Profile pages in the .NGO Directory will include information on key initiatives and other data of interest to potential donors or others looking to get involved.
- PIR is launching the .NGO
 Directory as a space for NGOs to collaborate and learn from one another.



Registration, Validation, and Setup

- **1** Register .NGO/.ONG name[s] with a Registrar
- 1 Begin the Validation process: Log-into the secure account management system to provide PIR your organization's information
- (2) Personalizing your directory profile: Upon registration approval, update your .NGO/.ONG profile with the information you want to share with the world



The .NGO/.ONG Validation System: Two Primary Elements

1. Validation Service Providers

Regional organizations confirm if organizations meet the **NGO Definition and Validation Criteria.** The providers send the **NGO Confirmation Data** to the **PIR NGO Validation Database.**

> NGO Validation Database

2. PIR NGO Validation Database

Managed by PIR, it contains a compiled list of all **NGO Confirmation Data**, as supplied to PIR by all of its **NGO Validation Service Providers**. The NGO Validation Database supports the .NGO and .ONG domain registration and activation process.

Maintaining the Integrity of Validation

- 1. PIR compliance checks. Random, monthly checks that registrants are still on current lists
- 2. Community Challenge Process. PIR will provide instruction for parties to challenge a .NGO/.ONG registrant's status (as meeting the PIR definition and criteria for a NGO), through a dispute resolution provider
- **3. Domain dispute resolution.** Existing, defined methods of dispute resolution that address rights to a .NGO/.ONG domain name
